This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students in the U2B NAPLAN domains of writing 17% in Year 7 and 22% in Year 9; Reading 25% in Year 7 and 22% in Year 9; Spelling 30% in Year 7 and 30% Year 9, Grammar and Punctuation 27% in Year 7 and 22% Year 9 and Numeracy 27% in Year 7 and 27% in Year 9
- Increase percentage of students at or above NMS to 98% in all NAPLAN domains
- Increase Levels of Achievement in Years 7, 8 and 9 to 65 % A's & B's in subjects studied
- Increase percentage of OP1-5 to 22% and percentage of OP 1-15 to 80%
- Increase percentage of Certificate III & IV qualifications across Senior Schooling with QCE attainment at 100%
