
- Increase the percentage of students in the U2B NAPLAN domains of writing 19% in Year 7 and 24% in Year 9; Reading 28% in Year 7 and 25% in Year 9; Spelling 35% in Year 7 and 35% Year 9, Grammar and Punctuation 30% in Year 7 and 25% Year 9 and Numeracy 28% in Year 7 and 28% in Year 9
- Increase percentage of students at or above NMS to 98% in all NAPLAN domains
- Increase Levels of Achievement in Years 7, 8 and 9 to 65 % A's & B's in subjects studied
- Increase percentage of Certificate III & IV qualifications across Senior Schooling with QCE attainment at 100%


