



MacGregor SHS Uniform Policy

MacGregor State High School dress standards project a positive image to the community and to employers. The Principal in consultation with the P&C and the student body endorse the dress code of the school. The staff supports these community expectations. By electing to enroll your child at MSHS, the expectation is that parents also support the wearing of correct uniform.

Students must wear formal school uniform at all times unless indicated otherwise. Correct school uniform must be worn travelling to and from school. On a Wednesday the School Sport uniform can be worn. Students who study practical subjects e.g. HPE, Dance etc. subjects must change into sports uniform at the break before their lesson and change back to formal uniform at the next available break. Mixing dress uniform with sport uniform is not acceptable.

- Students' hair must be neat and tidy and appropriate to a professional working environment.
- Hairstyles should not stand out through colour or style. If hair is below the collar, all hair is to be tied back.
- Hair accessories are to be either a plain red or green ribbon, or a plain hair tie. No hair clips, rollers or scrunchies.
- Adornments other than MacGregor school badges are not to be worn with the uniform.
- Facial hair is to be neatly presented.
- Make-up is not to be worn, including artificial eye-lashes.
- Nail polish is not to be worn, including artificial nails.
- Jewelry other than watches and medical alerts must not be worn and this is to comply with safety rules when participating in activities. An item of religious significance may be worn, but must not be able to be seen. The item must be removed when playing sport or participating in an activity where it could be a hazard.
- Visible tattoos are not permitted
- Students with pierced ears are permitted to wear one pair of small sleepers or studs. Other facial piercings are not permitted.
- Clothing other than the standard uniform is not acceptable. Plain white T shirts or white undergarments are only to be worn under the shirt or blouse. They are not to be visible below the sleeve or bottom of the shirt or blouse.
- Sun Safety – the school cap must be worn for HPE lessons and when on the oval at lunch breaks. Clear sunscreen is recommended when out in the sun.

Blouse	School white over blouse with peaked collar/ tartan trim.	Top button done up (Sleeves not rolled up)
Tie	Green school tie	Knot of tie to sit on top button of blouse
Socks	White crew length socks	No anklets or long calf length socks
Stockings	Black	Full length – no tights or leggings, not sheer.
Slacks	Bottle green or grey	Purchased only through Uniform Shop.

Tie	Green school tie	Optional in Terms 1 & 4, compulsory in Terms 2 & 3
Belt	Plain black belt	Simple, plain buckle
Socks	Grey crew length socks	No anklets or long calf length socks

Cap/bucket hat	MacGregor cap/hat only	Necessary when out in the sun. No other hats allowed
Bag	A MacGregor school bag only	Compulsory
Shoes	Plain black school shoes leather lace-up	Non-porous, solid uppers and solid sole. No canvas or slip-on shoes permitted.
Blazer	School bottle green, fine red pinstripe.	Purchase by pre-order only. Honour Pocket only with written authority of the school.
Jumper	School bottle green V-neck with red bands and lion emblem	Recommended minimum winter option
Vest	School bottle green V-neck with lion emblem	Optional
Waterproof Fleece lined jacket	School red jacket with emblem and school name on back	Optional (Green jacket to be phased out end of 2023)
Winter scarf	School scarf	
Headscarves, burqa or turban	Bottle green, white or black	To comply with religious requirements

SPORTS UNIFORM

Polo Shirt	Bottle green school polo	
Shorts	Bottle green school shorts	Do not shorten, no tights to be worn with shorts
Socks	White or grey crew length socks.	No anklets or long calf length socks
Sport shoes	Plain style lace-up cross trainer sport shoes.	Any sort of slip on or canvas shoe is not permitted
Cap/ Bucket Hat	MacGregor cap/bucket hat only	Must be worn with sports uniform

Uniform components to comply with religious requirements are available for purchase through the Uniform shop. Pre-orders are necessary.

MUSIC DEPARTMENT UNIFORM

The Black Performing Arts polo shirt is a compulsory item for all students in Instrumental and Vocal Music ensembles.

Students in Instrumental and Vocal Music are to have the following:

- Black Performing Arts polo shirt (as above)
- Plain black dress shirt – long sleeved with a collar (Performing Arts ties provided) – families are notified as required
- Black dress pants (jeans or leggings are unacceptable)
- Black socks
- Black leather shoes (as per school formal uniform)

SHORT TERM UNIFORM CONCERNS

When a student is unable to adhere to the uniform code, he/she must report to Student Services before 8:45am, with a note of explanation from their parent/caregiver to obtain a uniform pass for the day.

SENIOR JERSEY

Students are only permitted to wear their own school senior jersey.

SPORTS UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All students may wear Sports Uniform all day on Wednesday.

Students who have HPE/Recreational Studies in Period 1 or 2 are permitted to wear Sports Uniform to school and then need to change into Formal Uniform at Morning tea.

Students who have HPE/Recreational Studies in Period 3 or 4 will change into the Sports Uniform at Morning Tea and change back into Formal Uniform at Lunch or before going home.
